Top Tips for Teachers: Cambridge First Certificate in English Writing Skills

Many students "dry up" when faced with an oral speaking test, or talk too much and ignore what their partner has to say. The more familiar they are with what to expect, and what is expected of them, the less nervous they will be on the day. In this practical workshop we will discuss candidate performance via video samples, eliciting the good and not so good aspects, and what your students can do better. Applying the different assessment criteria will also allow you to measure your students' levels and highlight areas of communication that can compensate for weaker grammar. Classroom activities will help you build your students' confidence, and by the end of the session you should be fully aware of what your students need to focus on in order to perform well.
